Doors open and close!

Rumours that coffee house Zarraffa's is taking over the old Brodies Chicken outlet on Wood Street, Warwick, gathered momentum this week as the site was riddled with workers gutting the old joint. A Zarraffa's company spokesperson refused to be fully drawn but said it was possible a store may be open by Christmas. In other coffee news, The Coffee Club is still looking for a franchisee to open an outlet at the old Palm's on Palmerin site outside Rose City Shopping Centre, and Elle's Cafe in Warwick Twin Cinemas has an "under new management" sign. After decades of operation, Rose City icon, Hudson's Pies, closed its doors on Friday, as the current owners, AJ Butler Pty Ltd, opted for more family time. They had been trying to sell the business unsuccessfully, and are still offering the brand name to interested buyers. Meanwhile, Red Rooster is in "negotiations" with Rose City Shopping Centre to open a new kiosk in the food court, according to owner Neil McCosker.
